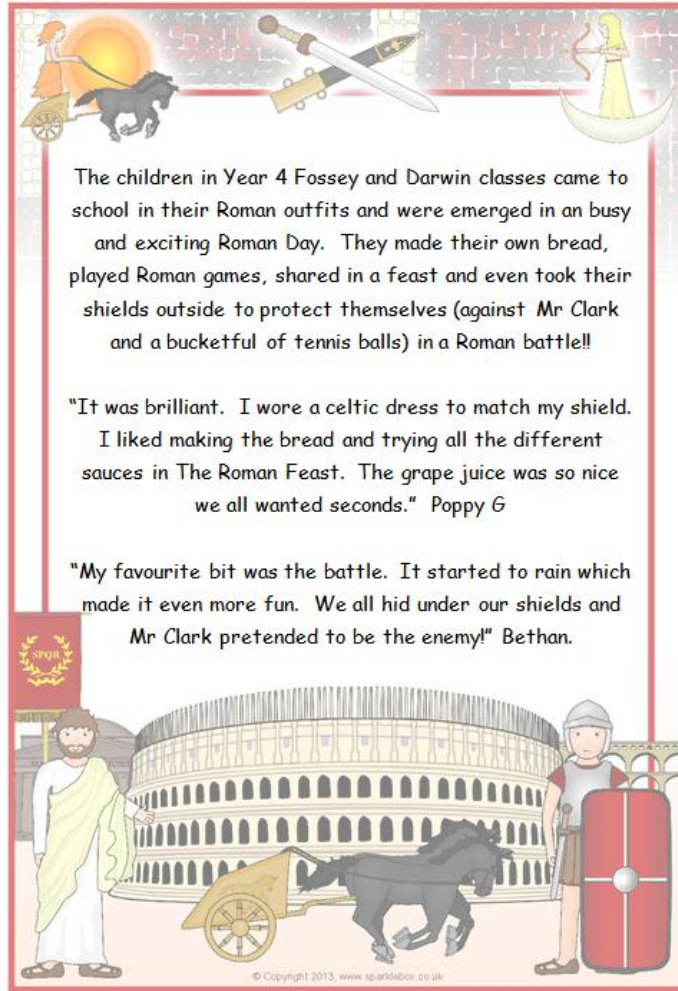
It is not essential to wear a red nose!

"My favourite bit was the battle. It started to rain which made it even more fun. We all hid under our shields and Mr Clark pretended to be the enemy!" Bethan.

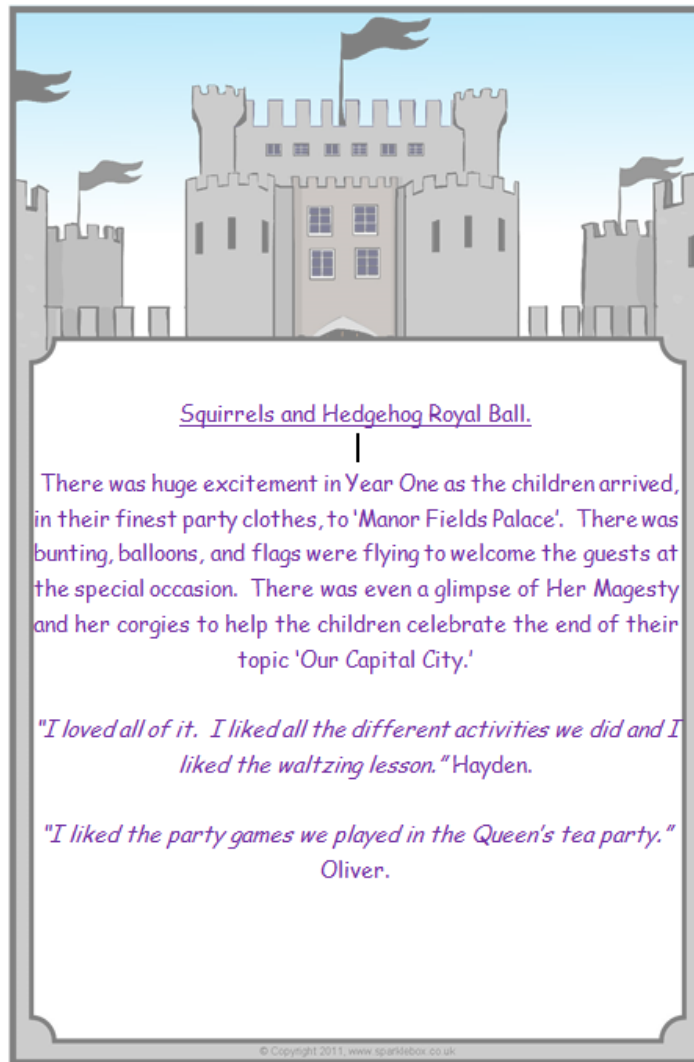
BAGS 2 SCHOOL

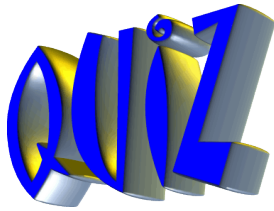
SUGGESTIONS WELCOME

JACKSON SQUARE BAKE-OFF

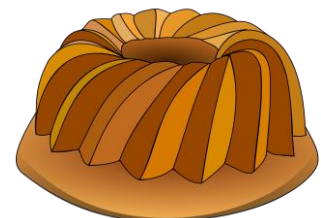
